YOUTH WILL BE AT THE HEART OF THE CONCERNS OVER CONFERENCE ON FUTURE OF EUROPE

REGIONS OF FRANCE SAID ON MAY9

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USPA NEWS - "As we celebrate this Monday, May 09, Europe Day in this European Year specially dedicated to youth, the Regions of France, the Grand Est Region and the European Committee of the Regions have invited the European Parliament and the Council to Strasbourg Greater East region more than 200 young high school students, apprentices and/or members of regional youth parliaments to raise their awareness of European issues and listen to their demands on the place they wish to occupy in the Europe of tomorrow. This delegation was first able to attend the presentation of the work of the Conference on the Future of Europe in the presence of the Presidency of the French Republic Emmanuel Macron and the Presidents of the European institutions." 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The day ended with the organization at the Grand Est Regional Council of the first dialogue on the participation of young people in public life and democratic debate at local, regional, national and European level, in the presence of the President of the Region, Jean Rottner, the President of the European Committee of the Regions, Apostolos Tzitzikostas, the President of the European Youth Forum, Silja Markkula, and the First Quaestor of the European Parliament, Anne Sander. After listening to the proposals of five young people from different Member States, including Ukraine, the debate focused on how to strengthen their participation in public life and decision-making processes.
