PRESIDENT HOLLANDE WELCOMES PM OF QATAR SHEIKH ABDUALLAH BIN KHALIFA AT ELYSEE

DISCUSSED FIGHTING AGAINST TERRORISM

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USPA NEWS - The President of the Republic received Sheikh Abdullah bin Nasser bin Khalifa Al-Thani, Prime Minister and Minister of Interior of Qatar, on Monday November 16. The meeting was attended by Their Excellences members of the official delegation accompanying HE the Prime Minister.

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The President of the Republic has informed him of our determination to fight against jihadist terrorism on all fronts - military, political, police and financial - and presented him the measures that have been decided in the wake of Friday's attacks.
